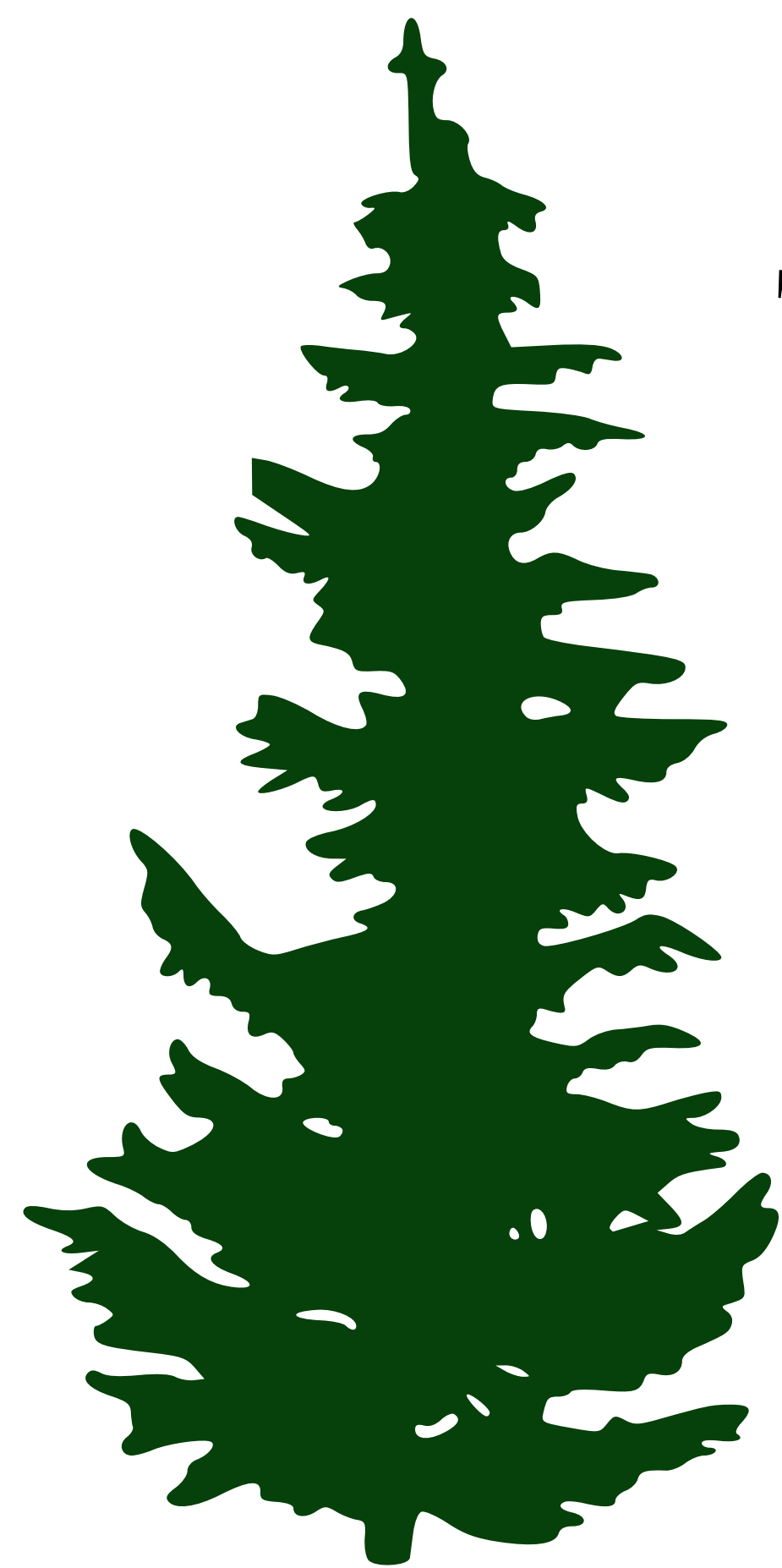

From HWY 20, go East on Yale-Kilgore Rd for about 3.9 Miles. Turn Left on Old Shotgun Rd and go about another 1.5 miles. Take a right onto Joseph Drive and then take an immediate right onto David Circle. Take the first left and the house is down the lane.

Check-In

Check-in time is 4:00pm on your day of arrival. The lock code will be given to you in a Booking Confirmation email 72 hours prior to your arrival.

Check-Out

Check-out time is no later than 10am. Please be sure to exit the home on time as we often have guests departing and arriving the same day. Which leaves the housekeepers only a small amount of time to prepare the home for the next guests. The property is inspected, sanitized, and cleaned after your departure. The cleaning fee you have paid will provide for normal cleaning so that you can enjoy your vacation up to the last moment.



Check-Out List

- Put all used dishes in the dishwasher and turn on
- Place all dirty towels in laundry room. Starting a load of laundry is appreciated but not required. Please wash white towels separate from colored hot tub towels.
- Place furniture in original placement.
- Leave beds as is and our housekeepers will take care of that for you.
- Dispose of all garbage in the cabin.
- Put cover back on hot tub. Latch it and leave the temperature at 104 degrees.
- Turn off ALL lights and small appliances. Make certain all burners and extra heaters are turned off.
- Lock ALL doors and windows.
- Make sure propane grill and tank is turned off and fire pit is fully extinguished .

Trash

There are garbage cans for your convince located outside the cabin. They are a little hard to open. They are bear proof and almost human proof :)

Laundry

A washer and dryer are in the house. Please feel free to wash linens, towels, and laundry at your discretion. Please wash the colored hot tub towels operate from the white linens/towels.



Heating & Cooling

Thermostat: Located in the hall towards the master bedroom. If you want to change the programmed setting, tap the thermostat and turn the silver ring to the desired temperature.

Fireplace: All you need to do to turn it on is to flip the light switch. It is located in the rock on the side by the front door. The blower is inside the bottom grate if you want to adjust the fan level.

Other Heat: There are also numerous space heaters in the house and extra blankets in each room.

Cooling: To cool the home down, open all windows and turn on all fans to create a nice cross-breeze. There are numerous fans throughout the cabin.



Hot Tub

- Please make sure and unlatch corners when in use and latch the cover when not in use. Our cleaning staff works hard to keep it clean, but the weather can mess it up.
- Please shower before use. A fee up to \$135 could be charged if the hot tub water needs extra care due to makeup/lotion/dirt/stuff.
- No glass allowed.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- Please use with care and caution.
- Call 911 for emergencies.
- Designated towels are provided. They are the colored ones in the tin container by the pool table.
- Report any problems with operations immediately to management.

Jacuzzi Tub

There is a Jacuzzi tub located in the master bathroom. It takes up most of the hot water in the cabin, so it may take 30-40 minutes to reheat the water heater.

Phone Signal

You should have ok phone signal, but it isn't always dependable. If you just want to tell people "I couldn't be reached..", your secret is safe with us.

Noise

Quiet hours start at 10:00pm. The hot tub and outdoor noise should be kept to a minimum. For noise in the cabin (like Dad's snoring) we have a few white noise machines in some of the bedrooms.

Septic System

Do not flush anything other than toilet paper. No feminine products should be flushed at any time.

Pet Rules

This cabin IS NOT PET FRIENDLY! If you miss your pet, you can look outside for wildlife.



Fire Pit

Be sure to check for current fire bans. Bring your own wood unless a kind soul before you left them. We have roasting sticks hanging up by the hot tub. Please be safe.

TV

TV/DVD: Every bedroom has a TV and a DVD player. Most DVD players are attached to the TV located on the back.

Cable with the Sports Package: The master bedroom and the basement family room have cable with the sports package.

X-Box: The basement family room has an Xbox with games. Extra batteries are in the pantry by the kitchen. If games get scratched or don't work, please put them in this folder so we can replace them.

DVD's: We have a binder with DVD's in it for your enjoyment. If movies get scratched or don't work, please put them in this folder so we can replace them.



Pantry

The pantry is located in the closet between the master bedroom and the laundry room. The top few shelves have items for your convince: a first aid kit, fire extinguisher, kitchen appliances and more.

Hide-a-Bed

The upstairs loft has a hide-a-bed. The linens for it are in a basket upstairs in the loft as well.

Babies

There are 3 Pack N' Plays throughout the cabin. there is a booster seat in the pantry, and toys are in the basement.



Hot Chocolate Maker

Heat & High Speed- Mixes and heats your drink at high speed. High speed is perfect for creating frothy drinks.

Cancel- Stops any function. “Cancel” can be pushed at any point in the cycle to turn the appliance off. Buttons will flash red to indicate that the appliance is still plugged in.

Froth & Dispense- Stirs your drink at a high speed, without adding heat, to mix and froth your drink for serving.

The Measurements below produce 60 ounces

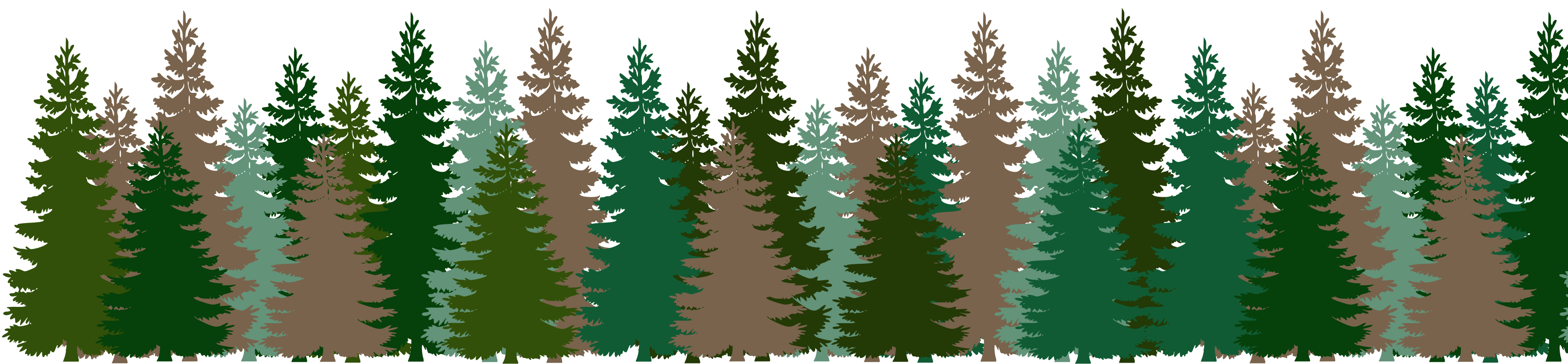
- Place mixing container on the motor base
- Pour 60 oz of water or milk and 1 cup of your favorite hot chocolate mix.
- Place the lid, press “Heat & High Speed” button. The selected control button will glow blue and your Cocoa Grande will begin to mix and heat. When the beverage reaches the “Perfect Temperature”, the appliance will automatically go idle. As the beverage cools down, the appliance will automatically reheat and remix back to the “Perfect Temperature”. The appliance will remain on until “Cancel” is pressed.
- A full 60 ounces take approximately 13 minutes to reach the “Perfect Temperature”.
- Once the appliance automatically goes idle, place a cup underneath the dispensing valve and press the “Froth & Dispense” button. This setting will mix the beverage while you dispense so that a rich layer of froth is dispensed into your cup along with the hot drink.
- After dispensing the beverage, select “Heat & High Speed” or “Heat & Low Speed” if there is still liquid in the mixing container. Press “Cancel” if there is less than 1 cup of beverage remaining.
