Nonprofit Partners with Local Communities to Deliver 1,000 Water Filters by 2026 in Puno and Cusco

HOPERU Humanitarian, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit (EIN 99-3720727, founded 2024), will launch its Q'umpi Clean Water Initiative in Puno and Cusco on July 31, 2025, to provide 1,000 water filters to underserved communities, aiming to reduce waterborne illnesses by 50%.

Initiative Details

Q'umpi Water Filter, developed with engineers and local municipalities, will distribute filters to 1,000 households by 2026. Each filter serves a family of five for two years. Training workshops empower communities to maintain filters.

Currently based in Idaho, where he attended Brigham Young University–Idaho, Helaman actively engages in entrepreneurial and academic endeavors while managing cross-continental humanitarian operations.
