Sunday (2 hours):

- Read General Conference talks regarding my weekly topics
- Prayerfully consider how to use these findings in the podcast
- Seek scriptures that help motivate and inspire (Share in the podcast)
- Contact my interviewees and schedule a time with them to meet (Professors, students, graduated students, etc.) (Tell them what the topic is and what I am aiming to discuss)

Monday (2 hours):

- Search social media, news, and other sources for recent news coverages that pertain to what has happened or what is happening with my topic
- Study certain political stances given by Presidents, Governors, Senators, Influencers, etc.
- Understand terminology and vocabulary in this field of topic

Tuesday (2 hours):

- Learn about the history of this topic and how it has affected (Positively or negatively) the nation and world
- Record my thoughts on the matter after my research and create a script (bullet points and not an essay)
- Come up with questions to ask my interviewees that not only pertain to them and their field, but also ask questions that cover their opinions and professional perspective

Wednesday (Filming Day- Interviews) (1 hour):

- Set up the equipment
- Stage the interview and remind the interviewee of the topic
- Film the Interview

Thursday (Filming Day- Podcast) (2-3 hours- Dependent):

- Set up my podcast setup
- Film the podcast and cover all my topics
- Review videos and ensure equipment is working

Friday (Editing):

- Film extra footage in case I missed anything
- Edit and review the podcast episode

Saturday (2 hours) (Release Day):
